

SCHOOL RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the faculty, staff, and students of _____ believe that methamphetamine has become a huge problem in the state of Alabama, causing untold misery to families and posing a threat to the health and welfare of thousands of people; and,

WHEREAS, the states of Oregon and Mississippi have passed laws making pseudoephedrine, the active ingredient in the manufacture of methamphetamine, available by prescription only, thereby dramatically reducing their drug caseload; and,

WHEREAS, methamphetamine cannot be manufactured without pseudoephedrine, a drug commonly found in over-the-counter cold and sinus products;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that our school urges our elected officials in the Alabama Legislature to initiate and support to passage a state law patterned after the one adopted in Mississippi, which makes pseudoephedrine a Schedule III drug which can only be obtained through a prescription from a licensed physician.
